Dear Sir,


I have just received back my letter sent to the Parliament of Great Britain 30 August 1993 (please see the enclosed copy).

I kindly ask you to get **my letter of August 1993, as well as copies of other three enclosed letters*** [of 16 June 1992, and of 19 April 1993 together with a copy of the letter by A J Smith, the Eastern Adriatic Unit of the Foreign & Commonwealth Office] **be made available to every member of the Parliament of Great Britain as well as to the Parliament offices in charge for Yugoslavia (ex -Socialistic Federal Republic of Yugoslavia).**

With hope that the Parliament and the Government of Great Britain will be able to find out *peaceful fair* way to help democratic (honest, free and equal right) solving the situation in Yugoslavia rather than to apply and/or support any military action increasing Yugoslav catastrophic tragedy, and with thanks in advance for your care about this matter,
