Dear Editor of the Webster's New World Encyclopedia

Kosovo - Metohiya and Vojvodina were not ever either constituent republics or republics of any Yugoslavia (Kingdom of Yugoslavia before the Second World War, or after the War in Federal Peoples Republic of Yugoslavia, in Socialist Federal Republic of Yugoslavia, in Federal Republic of Yugoslavia).
